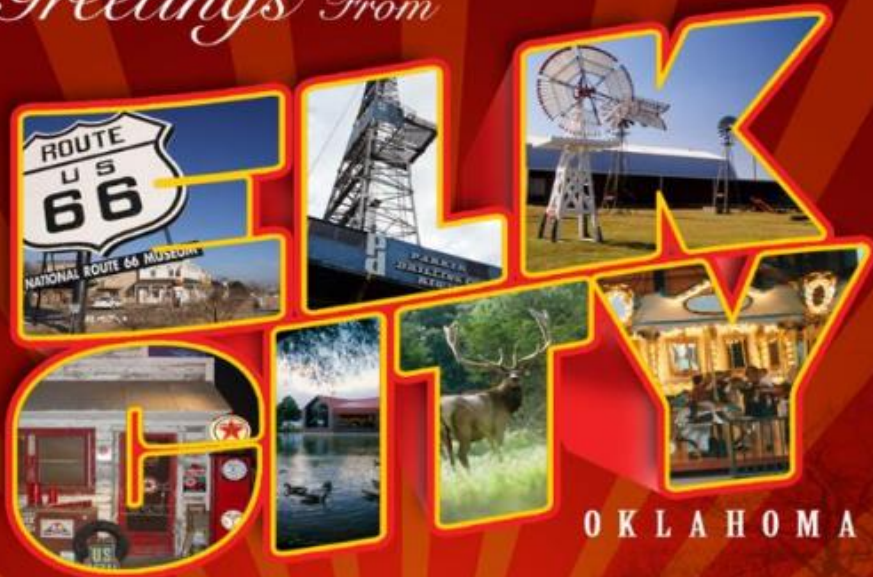

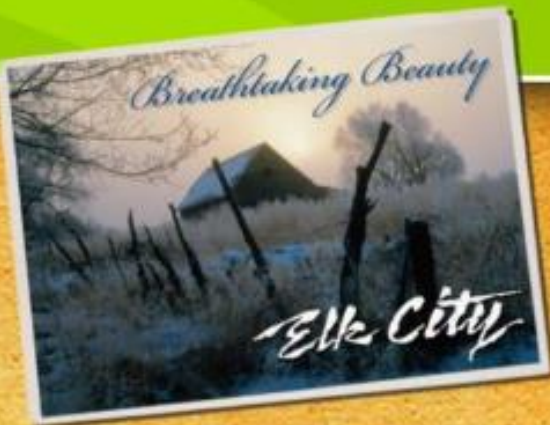
For entertainment, visitors can "get their kicks" at a variety of museums including the National Route 66 Museum, Old Town Complex and the one-of-a-kind Transportation Museum, which gives a great education in the history of how automobiles, trains and plains impacted travel in the United States. The Farm and Ranch Museum showcases decades of equipment used to harvest crops in the second largest industry in the state and the Blacksmith Museum takes you back to a time forgotten.

Elk City also hosts many events each year for tourists and visitors to enjoy. The Southwest Farm and Home Expo in April, the award winning annual PRCA Rodeo of Champions on Labor Day weekend, the Fall Festival in September, featuring the best in arts and crafts and the Oklahoma National Junior Heifer Show in November bring visitors from all over to showcase their stock. The largest Christmas light display in southwest Oklahoma, Christmas in the Park brings back old fashioned family traditions with train rides on the Candy Cane Express, old fashion horse-drawn carriages, light tours on the double decker bus and of course, kids of all ages enjoy a spin on the beautiful Centennial Carousel or a round of golf on the Putt-Putt golf course.

Elk City's vibrant downtown shopping district boasts everything from rustic cowboy décor to boutiques showcasing the latest in fashion. Make a day of shopping in Elk City during Route 66 Days in June, the Sizzlin' Summer Sidewalk Sale in July and scare up some frightful deals during Moonlight Madness in October.

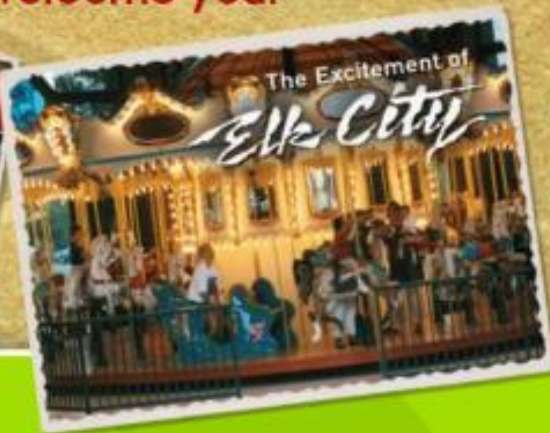
